Cumberland SSP Partnership	Buying into existing local sports networks such as school sports partnerships.	£4250	See separate document.
Sports day Years 1- 6 venue	Having a local school sports day off-site, where parents, family and friends can spectate the school's annual sports day. Access to the track and a grass playing field 50yards X 100yards.	£110	Pupils participate in fun sporting games and activities with their parents, friends and family spectating. Essential for their development in sport and the experience of being observed by others while they perform individually and in small teams.
Upgrading of Lunchtime provision and storage units for the lunchtime sporting equipment	Safe sports equipment purchased to actively engage all children at lunchtimes. Storage units built and placed in the playground for safe easy access to the sporting equipment. Equipment purchased for access to a wide range of sports.	£4719	Increased pupil participation in an active lunchtime. Pupils will have the opportunity to practise skills and techniques with sporting equipment usually only available to them during PE and afterschool clubs. Help to create a safer lunchtime environment.
