We will be selling red noses for £1.25 from Monday 11th March. Please bring the exact amount of money as we will be unable to provide change.

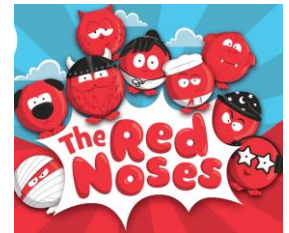
All contributions will go towards reducing poverty around the world by supporting the charity work of Comic Relief.
