English

- In Reading pupils will have daily phonics lessons where they will be learning a new sound a week. Pupils will be learning to blend and segment sounds to develop their early reading skills.
- In Writing pupils will use their understanding of sounds taught in phonics to begin to write simple words and sentences.

This half terms key texts are:

Jack and the Beanstalk, Mr Wolf's Pancakes, Goldilocks and the Three Bears, The little Red Hen

Science

How do Plants Grow: We will be working with the school gardeners and planting our own beanstalks.

Mathematics

Number: Pupils will learn to:

- Recite numbers in order to 10 and above
- Compare two groups of objects saying when they have the same number.
- Represent numbers using fingers and marks
- Begin to recognise numbers in the environment
- Counts objects to 10 and beyond

Space, shape, & Measure: Pupils will learn to:

Name 2D shapes and begin to discuss the properties of 2D shapes. We are also looking at making patterns.
