If there are any further questions or queries, please do not hesitate to ask your child's teacher.

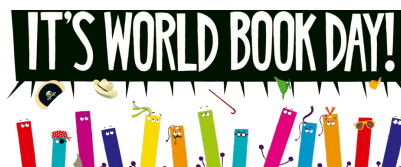


World Book Day
